THEME-SPECIFIC PROGRAMS

Base PROM	The payable program is stored on this PROM, which is a 27C240 device. The label indicates BASE and the payable version (W0000176).
Character Flash Card(s)	This program requires 8 MB of memory. The CG number is C0000510.
Pixel Flash Card(s)	This program requires 8 MB of memory. The pixel number is C0000510.
DSS Flash Card	The enhanced sound is stored on a multimedia lite board II. Set all DIP switches to off. The sound program number is DSS00050.
Reel Driver	Reel Driver RD0007 (and subsequent RD versions) is a slave program that spins the mechanical bonus wheel.
Spectrum Display	SD0102 or its upgrade is required for surface-mount spectrum controller boards that use PLCC PROMs. SD0092 is required for old-style spectrum displays that use DIP PROMs.

NOTE: This game requires processor board p/n 757-039-0x.

GAME TYPE

This MegaJackpot version of Wheel of Fortune Triple Chance is a 5-reel, 45-coin, 9-payline game. It contains one \$0.05 game (paytable) and two bonus games: Triple Chance Bonus and Bonus Wheel of Fortune Puzzle. It supports single denomination, hopper, and thermal printer capabilities. The MegaJackpot system ID for this version must be set to 37.
